On-Course Contests for Individual Awards

★ Closest to the Pin - 2nd Shot at Hole #11

Aim with finesse! On this par-4 hole, the player whose second shot lands nearest the pin on the green wins. Ball must be on the green to qualify.

★ Longest Drive at Hole #18 (Men's & and Women's)

Let it fly! The player with the longest tee shot that lands and stays in the fairway wins. Power up and swing big—but keep it straight to qualify!

TOURNAMENT RULES

Tee Designation:

- Red Tees Forward tees (women)
- White Tees Standard tees (men)

4-Person Scramble: All players tee off on each hole.

- The team selects the best tee shot and marks the spot.
- All players then hit their next shot from that spot (within one club length, no closer to the hole).
- This process repeats until the ball is holed.
- On the green, balls should be marked and all putts taken within 6 inches of the original marker, no closer to the hole.
- Record one team score per hole and note whose tee shot was used.

Tee Shot Requirement:

Each player's tee shot must be used at least 3 times over 18 holes.

Handicaps & Scoring:

Team handicaps will be calculated based on "blind" holes selected by the pro shop. Prizes will be awarded to:

- 1st and 2nd Place Low Gross Teams
- 1st and 2nd Place Low Net Teams
- 2nd to Last Booby Team (Net)

Playing from Lies:

If the chosen ball lies in the rough, bunker, or hazard, players must play from that same condition—no relief using the one-club-length rule. (e.g., a ball in the rough must be played from the rough.)

Mulligans:

Purchased mulligans may be used on any shot, but do not count for prizes on designated "Hit the Green" competition holes.

Teams of 3 Players:

If a group has only three players, they will rotate hitting a fourth shot:

- Assign players A, B, and C.
- Player A hits an extra shot on Hole 1, B on Hole 2, and C on Hole 3, and continue rotating throughout the round.
- The extra shot includes tee shots and continues through each hole.

TOURNAMENT RULES

ティーの指定:

赤ティー / 前方ティー(女性) 白ティー / 標準ティー(男性)

フォーマット:4人1組のスクランブル方式

- 各プレーヤーが各ホールでティーショットを打ちます。
- チームで最も良いティーショットを選び、その位置をマークします。
- その位置から、全員が次のショットをホールに近づかない1クラブレングス以内で打ちます。
- このプロセスを繰り返し、ボールをカップインするまでプレーします。
- グリーン上では、ボールにマークをし、**マーカーから6インチ以内(ホールに近づかない方向)**からパットを行ってください。
- 各ホールではチームで1つのスコアを記録し、どのプレーヤーのティーショットを使用したかも記録してください。

ティーショットの使用条件:

各プレーヤーのティーショットを、18ホール中最低3回は使用してください。

ハンディキャップとスコアリング:

プロショップが選定する「ブラインドホール(隠しホール)」を基に、チームのハンディキャップが算出されます。以下の賞が授与されます:

- グロススコア1位・2位チーム
- ネットスコア1位・2位チーム
- 下から2番目のネットスコアチーム(ブービー賞)

ボールのライ(位置)について:

選ばれたボールがラフ、バンカー、またはハザードにある場合は、同じ状況からプレーしてください。1クラブレングスルールを使用して救済を受けることはできません。 (例:ラフにある場合、全員ラフから打ってください)

マリガン(打ち直し):

購入したマリガンは任意のショットで使用可能ですが、コンペティションホール(3番、6番、13番、16番)ではマリガンによるスコアは賞の対象となりません。

3人チームの場合:

グループが3人の場合は、交代で4人目のショットを担当します。

- プレーヤーA、B、Cと割り当ててください。
- 1ホール目ではAが追加ショット(2回目)を担当し、2ホール目はB、3ホール目はC と順番にローテーションします。
- このローテーションを全ホールで繰り返してください。
- 追加ショットはティーショットを含め、各ホール終了まで続けてください。
